Ar an 30ú lá Lúnasa, 2022, i bhfeidhmíú na gcumhachtaí a thugtar dó faoi alt 51 d'Acht na Bóithre 1993 (leasaithe), rinne an Bord Pleanála ordú chun cead a thabhairt, faoi réir coinneolaíochta, don bhóthar atá beartaithe faoi mar a chuir Comhairle Cathrach agus Contae Luimnigh faoina bhraí.

Seo a leanas achoimre de choinneolaíochta chinneadh an Bhoird:

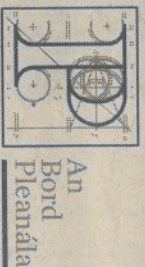
1. Déanfar agus críochnófar an fhorbairt bheartaithe de réir na bpleananna agus na sonraí a cuirtear faoi bhráid an Bhoird Pleanála leis an iarratas agus ag an éisteacht ó bhéal.
2. Déanfaidh an contraitheoir ceaptha an Plean Oibríocháin Comhshaoil (EOP) a thabhairt chun críche agus a chur chun feidhme agus beidh sé faoi réir a fhaomhadh foirmlíúil ón údarás bóithre agus ní sháróidh aon imeacht na heifeachtaí comhshaoil a bhfuil gealltanas tugtha ina leith san EIAR agus san EOP.
3. Déanfaidh an t-údarás bóithre teagmháil le húisce éireann chun cosaint Imleor na sócmhainní suntasacha atá ann dheana a chomhaontú agus a chinntiú go gcoimeadtar rochtain chui.
4. Déanfar Sceideal na nGealltanas Comhshaoil a nuashonrú chun bearta maolaithe breise agus sonraí eile a chorporú ann agus cuirfear chun feidhme iad ina n-íomláine.
5. Le linn chéim na tógála, ceapfar daoine le príomhrólí chun maoirseacht a dhéanamh ar ghnéithe ábhartha an tionscadail, lena n-áirítear na gealltanas chromshaoil a gealladh sa Tuairascáil ar Mheasúnú Tionchair, Ráiteas Tionchair Natura agus an t-iarratas go ginearálta.

Notice of a decision by An Bord Pleanála in relation to the proposed Foynes to Limerick Road (including the Adare Bypass) including all ancillary and consequential works.

Further to the Board's notice published on the 12th and on the 14th September, 2022 you are advised that the URL was omitted from the notice in error. The URL is now specified as follows: <https://www.pleanala.ie/en-ie/case/306146>

An Bord Pleanála has, on the 30th day of August, 2022, in exercise of the powers vested in it by section 51 of the Roads Act, 1993, as amended, made an order to approve subject to conditions the proposed road as submitted by Limerick City and County Council.

The conditions of the Board's decision are summarised as follows:

1. The proposed development shall be carried out and completed in accordance with the plans and particulars submitted to An Bord Pleanála with the application and at the oral hearing.
2. The Environmental Operating Plan (EOP) shall be finalised and implemented by the appointed contractor and shall be subject to formal approval by the road authority and any deviations shall not cause an exceedance of the environmental effects committed to in the EIAR and EOP.
3. The road authority shall engage with Irish Water to agree adequate protection of existing significant assets and ensure appropriate access is maintained.
4. The Schedule of Environmental Commitments shall be updated to incorporate additional mitigation measures and other details and shall be implemented in full.
5. During the construction phase, persons with key roles to oversee the relevant aspects of the project, including the environmental commitments that have been committed to in the Environmental Impact Assessment Report, Natura Impact Statement and the application generally, shall be appointed.

A person may question the validity of a decision by the Board by way of an application for judicial review, under Order 84 of the Rules of the Superior Courts (S.I. No. 15 of 1986), in accordance with section 50 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended.
